At 260 hectares, Backus Woods is one of the largest Carolinian forest areas in Canada with mature forest making up three-quarters of the woods. Backus Woods boasts a variety of tree species including black oak, beech, sugar maple, red maple, silver maple and yellow birch. Samples of American sweet chestnut, black gum and tulip trees can also be seen. There is a variety of bird species, snakes (Garter & the rare Eastern Hognose), plus the usual squirrels and chipmunks. The Backus Heritage Village is also on site where more than 15 reconstructed heritage buildings can be seen.

9:45 a.m. Arrival at Backus Heritage Conservation Area

Hike at Backus Woods. You may choose the long, medium or short hike. (see hike template). After you finish your hike you can spend the rest of the day exploring the Heritage Village Area.

4:30 p.m. Depart Heritage Conservation Area. (may depart earlier depending on completion of hikes).

6:00 p.m. arrive Burlington

- Backpack
- Hiking boots with good tread, poles optional
- Dress in layers according to weather
- Rainwear
- Bug and sun protection
